### **Letter from the Board of Directors**

On behalf of the Board of Directors for Corvallis Waldorf School, I am pleased to share our 2014-2015 Annual Report. The past year was very significant for the school, and the Board specifically. Much like the rhythms in our classrooms, the work of the Board had a detailed, inward focus at times, and an outward, “big picture” perspective at other times.

The Board further clarified their role as the governing body of the organization, moving away from a “Management Team” model and towards a “Policy Governance” model. This transition allowed our talented administrative team to assume full responsibility for the day-to-day operation of the school, and they did a fantastic job.

We finished the year with 154 students enrolled, well above projections, and we achieved the most successful Annual Giving Campaign in our history, raising \$60,000. As a result, a reserve fund was established for the school, an important step that has long been a part of the vision for the school. Additionally, we sited and opened Oregon’s first SAGE building in time for the start of fall classes, adding beauty and value to our campus. The Board is grateful for the administrative work of Peter Zaremba, School Director, Diane Martin, Director of Business Operations, Tim Love, Facilities Director, Melissa Montague, Administrative Assistant, and Maggie Bahnson, Enrollment and Volunteer Coordinator.

The faculty has continued to offer an unparalleled experience for our children, and for that the community is always grateful. Driven by their mission to provide the best education possible, the College of Teachers continued studying Rudolph Steiner’s writings to deepen their understanding of Waldorf pedagogy.

Over the course of the year, Jason Seivers, Wendy Willard, Pansy Kemp, and Andy Luck stepped down from the Board. On behalf of the school community, I would like to thank each of these dedicated individuals for their service.

The roles of the Board, faculty, administration, and Parent Council became more distinct in 2014-2015, but we continued to work and grow together, enabling us to build a solid foundation for future opportunities. Thank you for supporting our efforts to serve the community through Waldorf education.

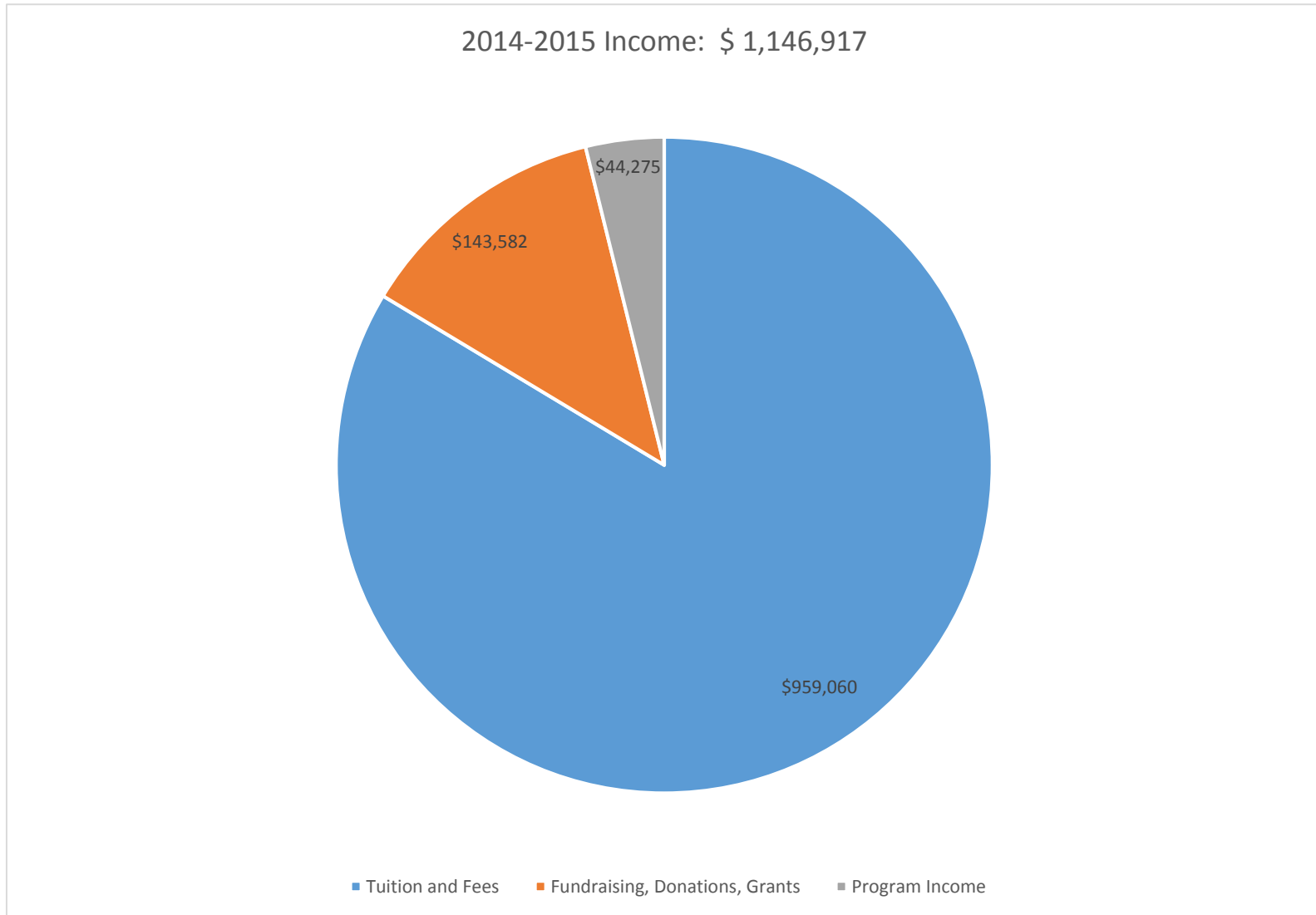

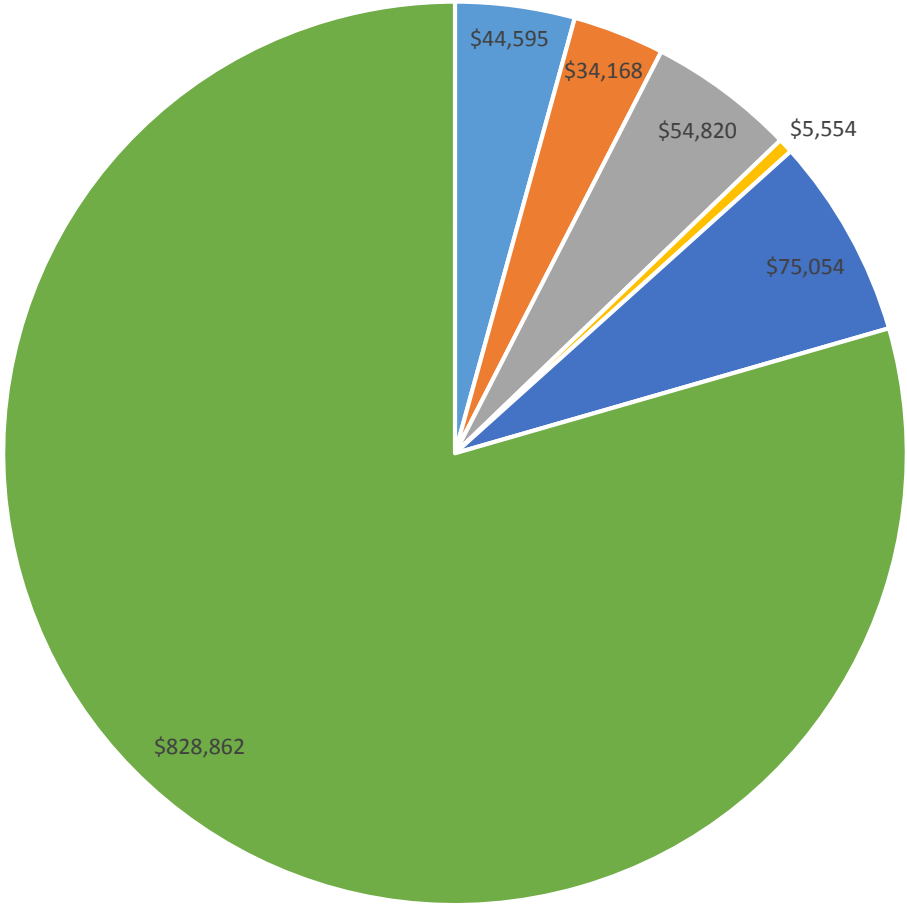
